

## White's Residential Admission Criteria

White's Residential & Family Services, Inc. Residential Program is a long-term placement alternative. An average placement is nine to 18 months in duration.

The youth must be under the wardship of a court or county DCS office at time of placement. White's Residential Services will accept referrals from:

- County Probation Departments
- County Division of Child Services
- Department of Corrections
- Hospital settings or other similar referring agencies

Academically, youth must be eligible for enrollment in 6th through 12th grades with an IQ exceeding 75.

White's works best with youth who have experienced:

- Effects of physical abuse
- Effects of sexual abuse
- Poor school performance (chronic truancy, disruptive)
- Anger outbursts
- Depression

White's will also accept youth who have committed acts of delinquency:

- Crimes against property
- Incurable behavior at home and in the community
- Chronic run away
- Sexually maladaptive behaviors

White's ordinarily does not accept residents who are arsonists, who suffer from severe emotional disturbances or personality disorders, or who are highly assaultive.

The placing agency should submit a complete social and medical history, available psychiatric, psychological, school and court information.

White's and/or the placing agency may request a pre-placement visit as a condition of acceptance.

Upon acceptance, a pre-admission packet will be forwarded to the placing agency. White's Residential & Family Services, Inc. is responsible for the pre-admission physical.
